


**Ahmad Albattat** Is An Associate Professor In Graduate School Of Management, Management And Science University, Malaysia.

The participants will have an opportunity to visit all the four important religious sites during the APIRTP 2024 Conference to experience religious diversity and harmony in the state of Goa.


