The Asia Pacific International Religious Tourism and Pilgrimage Conference (APIRTP) organized by the Institute for Religious Tourism and Pilgrimage (IRTP) in conjunction with the International Journal of Religious Tourism and Pilgrimage (IJRTP), Universitas Islam Malang invites abstracts for their 2nd International Conference to be held from 17 – 19 January 2024 at Universitas Islam Malang.



- ritial Abstracts must not exceed 1 page of A4 (including title, data, figures and references).
- Please use 10-point Arial font, single-spaced and set margins to 1 inch (2.54cm) all around.
- Abstracts will be subjected to blind review by a minimum of two referees from the Scientific Committee.
- Please include a list of five keywords that describe the research just under the title of the paper to assist the reviewing process
- Include 3 bibliographic references at the bottom of the abstract.


Submission Process





BY PLANE

From Jakarta to Malang

You can fly directly from Jakarta to Malang. The airport of Malang is called Abdul Rachman Saleh. It refers to an Indonesian hero who had fought for Indonesian independence. The old airport belongs to Indonesian Air Forced and since a couple of months there is a new building of the airport that is used for commercial aim.

There are 4 airline companies that operate in Abdurrahman Saleh airport. They are Garuda Indonesia, Citilink, Batik Air, Super Air Jet, and Lion Air. The following is their schedule. The flight Jakarta-Malang takes about 1 hour and 20 minutes.

From Jakarta to Surabaya

You can fly directly to Surabaya from Jakarta. The airport of Surabaya is called Juanda Airport. After that you can go to Universitas Islam Malang from Juanda Airport by travel which cost around Rp 150.000 or \$10 per pax.

There are 4 airline companies that operate in Sukarno-Hatta Airport. They are Garuda Indonesia, Citilink, Super Air Jet, and Lion Air. The following is their schedule. The flight Jakarta-Surabaya takes about 1 hour 30 minutes.

From Denpasar (Bali) to Malang

You can fly directly to Surabaya from Denpasar. The airport of Bali is called Ngurah Rai Airport. After that you can go to Universitas Islam Malang from Juanda Airport by travel which cost around Rp 150.000 or \$10 per pax.

There are 4 airline companies that operate in Ngurah Rai Airport. They are Garuda Indonesia, Citilink, Air Asia and Lion Air. The following is their schedule. The flight Denpasar-Surabaya takes about I hour. Remember that there is time difference between Bali and Malang. Bali is I hour earlier (ahead) than Malang.

BY BUS

From Surabaya to Malang

If you want to go by bus, it takes around 1 hours 45minutes, and costs IDR 20.00-40.000 per person. You will arrive in Arjosari Bus Terminal. After that, you can go UNISMA by Taxi or Online

From Jakarta to Malang

If you want to go by bus, it takes around 12 hours, and costs IDR 350.000-580.00 per person. You will arrive in Arjosari Bus Terminal. After that, you can go to UNISMA by Taxi or Online transportation.

BY TRAIN

From Jakarta to Malang

Another option if you go to Malang is by train (in Indonesian it is called kereta api) There are two kinds of train from Jakarta to Malang. They call it Business and Executive class. The Business stops in every small station they pass. So, I recommend you to take The Executive.
